CAMBODIAN CULTURAL VILLAGE

Immerse yourself in Cambodia's history as legends and folklore come to life at Cambodian Cultural Village. The 210,000 square metre attraction is a celebration of the individual traditions, history and practices of the various ethnic groups of Cambodia and a charming feast for the senses.

An energetic troupe of Cambodian youth recreate the diversity of Cambodia's cultural groups through theatre, acrobatics and dance. Marvel as mythic legends are revealed, gain insights into the traditional Cambodian act of wooing a fiancé or witness the charm of a simulated Khmer Wedding Ceremony.

GOLDEN SILK FARM

Learn the techniques and history of silk weaving at this working silk farm committed to producing only the finest golden silks. Once a thriving industry, the traditional production of golden silk has almost disappeared due to complicated production techniques and low yield. The Golden Silk Farm is dedicated to restoring and safeguarding the fabulous Khmer traditional methods and techniques of golden silk production. Spread across more than 12 hectares of a mulberry tree plantation and workshops, this working farm offers unique insights into this ancient craft and has provided employment opportunities for orphans and disadvantaged rural people in the surrounding area since 2002.

TONLE SAP LAKE

KOMPONG PHLUK & THE FLOODED FOREST

Watch the colours of the sky transform, and the sun sink into an inspired journey through the floodplains of Tonle Sap Lake and witness the incredible stilted houses of Kompong Phluk. Relax as you take in the sights and sounds of these delightfully different abodes, drifting past fishermen, boat makers, schools, markets and throngs of waving children. A local guide is on hand to provide valuable insights into the culture, lifestyle and ecosystem of the authentic villages. The landscape alters dramatically between wet and dry seasons where the lake rises almost to the door of the houses or the stilted houses tower over you; up to six metres above the water line.

Following your time at Kompong Phluk, you'll float your way to the flooded forest, where you'll glide through a labyrinth of submerged trees where the only sounds you'll hear are the rhythmic paddle of the oars and an almost otherworldly experience.

PREK TOAL BIOSPHERE RESERVE

When nature calls, whisk yourself away to this bird watcher and animal lover's paradise. Home to one of the most important colonies of endangered water birds in Southeast Asia, the freshwater lake is one of the largest in Asia, swelling to 12,000 square kilometres over the wet season. Almost 150 species of birds, like rare painted storks, greater and lesser adjuncts and spot-billed pelicans call the area home.

Along with the rich ornithological offerings, the area counts crocodiles, turtles and more than 200 species of fish as local residents in one of the region's richest examples of biodiversity. The areas surrounding the lake are similarly distinctive, with floating villages, towering stilted houses and an economy and way of life intertwined with the water system, the fish and the cycles of rising and falling waters.

SUNSET AT CHONG KHNEAS

Relax and take in the stunning natural beauty of Tonle Sap Lake as we navigate our way through floating houses, markets, villages and schools. HALF DAY TEMPLE TOUR

Unravel the mysteries of the ancient Khmer capital and bear witness to the stunning ruins of Angkor Wat with this private half day tour.

Enjoy the undivided attention of your Temple Guru as he takes you on an informative adventure through the world famous Angkor Wat, the best preserved of all the temples in the Angkor Archaelogical Park. Embrace the sense of awe and inspiration as you watch the sun rise over the triple towers of the world's largest religious monument. As the crowds thin, take an unforgettable tour of the temple, where the gentle light and cooler temperatures present Angkor at its best.

Following a hearty breakfast continue to explore either the multi-faced Bayon temple or appreciate nature's chokehold of Ta Prohm or explore the maze of vaulted corridors of Preah Khan.

FULL DAY TEMPLE TOUR

Ride in comfort to the Angkor Archaelogical Park and wander the temple complex with our resident Guru offering scholarly insight into the awe inspiring site dating back to the Khmer Empire.

Our morning commences with a peaceful walk through the east causeway as the park begins to come to life. An early start ensures we can secure a prime position to catch the sun's earliest rays illuminating the spectacular Angkor Wat. Following an informative tour through the history of Angkor Wat, we settle in for a hearty and nutritious breakfast – fuel for a full day's adventure.

Pass through the 54 demons that guard Angkor Thom City's South Gate. Take in the splendour of Bayon, with its 200 stone faces keeping vigil over the centre of this walled village. Journey to the tranquil Pasat Ta Nei, shrouded deep in the jungle, nature slowly reclaiming the ancient stone structure before the day concludes with a visit to Ta Phrom, popularized by the movie Tomb Baider.

OUTLYING TEMPLES HALF DAY

Escape the ever present crowds at the major temples of the Angkor Archaelogical Park and enjoy wandering the captivating temples of Banteay Srei and Banteay Samre in solitude.

Travelling through the pristine countryside, you'll pass glimpses of rural Cambodian life like immaculately uniformed children walking to school and their parents tending the fields as you make your way to these forgotten temples. Some of the most elegant carvings in the region can be found at Banteay Srei, with sensuous celestial dancers carved into the hard red sandstone that dates back to the 10th century. Banteay Samre is similarly artistically exquisite and represents one of the most complete complexes at Angkor thanks to extensive restoration efforts.

PROGRESSIVE TEMPLE CIRCUIT

Immerse yourself into the ancient religion of Buddhism with a visit to a monastery, complete with a monk blessing, on this tour of three beautiful and secluded temple sites. Our first stop in West Baray is a beautiful rice paddy, overlooked by a Buddhist monastery. The two temples featured in this itinerary are excluded from most regular tours and guides and are located in the middle of the jungle with access only possible through an exotic road crossing the jungle. Combine your tour with a Dining by Design breakfast, lunch or high tea for a truly enchanting experience.

BIKING

HORSE RIDING

From sunrise to sunset, horses will take you on a journey to places that are otherwise unreachable. With placid ponies for beginners through to lively geldings for advanced riders, we are able to customise the perfect tour for your needs and ability level.

Peaceful villages and scenic rice fields form the backdrop as you cycle through the countryside for an authentic taste of Khmer lifestyle. Observe local craftsmen, farmers tending their crops and see real Cambodia on horseback.

Considered a holy mountain in Cambodia, it is a place of religious significance and pilgrimage for both Buddhists and Hindus alike. Leave the crowds of the main Angkor complex behind and feel the wind rush across you face as you pass through quaint countryside and rice fields before you reach the Kulen range. Wander through the jungle. Admire the thousands of linga carvings under the water stream. Cool off under the spectacular cascades of the waterfall. Gaze in wonder at the 16h century statue of a grand reclining Buddha.

GOLF

ANGKOR GOLF RESORT

The Sir Nick Faldo designed Angkor Golf Resort opened in January 2008. It is without doubt the finest golf course in Cambodia, and any keen golfer visiting Siem Reap should play at least one round here.

A challenging but fair layout, always presented in immaculate condition. A variety of tee-boxes ensure players of different abilities enjoy their game. Strategically placed bunkers and water hazards will keep you thinking throughout your round.

PHOKEETHRA COUNTRY CLUB

The Phokeethra Country Club was the first true international standard golf course to open in Cambodia in 2007. For four years through to 2010 it staged the Asian PGA tour event Johnnie Walker Cambodian Open. The course is designed to championship standard and will test your strategic skills.
